



WKFHA Registration FAQ

How can I register for the 2020-2021 season?

Registration can be done online at <http://www.wkfha.ca/> . Go to this webpage and click on the "Registration Link" located on the home page.

What if my daughter is transferring from another association?

Please contact the WKFHA registrar (Crystal Leger) at crystal.leger2016@gmail.com. She will need your daughter's date of birth, full name and hockey identification number if you have one. Please indicate whether or not your daughter will be a dual registration (playing for both the co-ed and the female hockey associations).

If your daughter is playing with two hockey associations, you will need to fill out another form indicating which association will be your primary association. The insurance fee will only be paid to the primary association. Please go to the website <http://www.wkfha.ca> and click "forms" to locate the **Dual Registration Agreement** form.

How much does registration cost?

Registration amounts defer depending on the level your daughter is in.

Initiation (U7): \$300

Novice (U9): \$350

Atom (U11): \$450

Peewee (U13): \$500

Bantam (U15): \$500

Midget (U18): \$500

Which types of payment are accepted?

At this time, we will be accepting e-transfers. Send the amount based on the registration division to wkfhablizzards@gmail.com.

Please include:

- **full name** of your daughter
- **date of birth** of your daughter
- use **hockey2020** for the password

How do I create an account to register?

- Go to the website

- Click "create an account".
- Enter the information requested (name, home address, phone numbers, email address, emergency contact information)
- After you create your account, you will then need to register, add the file to 'your cart' and check out.

Mandatory Parent Courses

All parents **MUST** complete:

Parent Respect in Sport training program.

- This can be found on the **Hockey New Brunswick website**.
- Go to <https://www.hnb.ca/en/>.
- Click on **Clinics**.
- Scroll down to **Parent Respect in Sport** and you will be directed to the program.
- Please note that if you are a coach, you must complete the **Respect in Sport Leader** program **AS WELL**—these programs are **NOT** the same.

- There is a cost to the program which you will be asked to pay upon course registration and before the course begins.

Note:

The **Respect in Sport program** only needs to be completed by one parent, one time, and once it is completed, you will not have to complete it again.

This must be completed by **December 15th**, or your daughter will not be permitted on the ice. This is a hockey Canada rule.

If you have completed the Respect in Sports Program for another child, you can log into the program and link your second child to your profile. There is no need to take the course a second time.

What kind of certification is required for coaches?

(The way these courses are presented may differ from past years due to Covid-19. The Director of Coaching will guide anyone who wishes to coach.)

There are online courses, offered by HNB that must be completed. These would include:

- **Respect in Sports Leader** (online)
- **IP & Novice:** Coach Level 1 (on ice 1 or 2 days)
- **Atom/Peewee/Bantam/Midget:** HU Online Coach 1 &2, Coach level 2 (on ice 1 or 2 days)
- **Peewee AAA/Bantam AAA:** Development 1 (on ice 1 or 2 days)

All coaches and team managers **MUST** have an up to date **Criminal Record check** and a **Vulnerable Sector Check**.

- Print off the cover letter labelled "Criminal Record Check/Vulnerable Sector Check located under "Forms" on <http://www.wkfha.ca>.
- If you think that you have an up-to-date CRC and VSC, contact Crystal Leger (crystal.leger2016@gmail.com) and she can verify the expiration dates.

What happens if my daughter decides she no longer wants to play hockey?

With the beginning of the 2020-2021 hockey season approaching, amidst this global pandemic, the WKFHA Board of Directors thought it was prudent to implement a clear Covid-19 refund policy. However, it closely models our current policy. Refunds are determined on a percentage of the season that has already been played.

Whether a family chooses to leave the organization due to personal reasons, or the potential for HC suspending the season due to a second wave of Covid-19, the refund amounts will remain the same as previous years.

Refund dates and Percentages

- November 15th 75%
- December 15th 50%
- January 15th 25%
- January 31st 0%

Of course, there are always extenuating circumstances that can be looked at on an individual basis, and brought before the board, for a ruling.
